



The Lung Association Medical and Scientific Section Lifetime Achievement Award

- Purpose:** To honour excellence in scientific research in respiratory diseases or contribution to the Respiratory Medicine community over at least ten years.
- Eligibility:** Exemplary achievements, where the work demonstrates a high degree of expertise, creativity, imagination, perseverance, and/or dedication. The individual must be a member of the Lung Association M&SS for a minimum of five (5) years. This award may not be given more than once in a lifetime. May not necessarily be awarded every Lorraine Award cycle (every 2 years).
- Nomination Deadline:** February 15th 2008
- How to Nominate:** Nominations will be accepted from any TLA member. These should consist of 3 copies of the following:
- Award nomination cover letter, detailing research, accomplishments, and contributions to respiratory medicine and /or respiratory research over at least 10 years.
